Then, we will get into negotiations that might last a few days – we will decide the price and when it will be done and how it will be delivered. If I have questions to clarify what you want, I will ask them during this time. Additionally, I will create a sketch or thumbnail of what you want, and/or ask for you to provide me with a few reference images so that you can visually confirm what the end product will look like.

After you have approved the sketch, and before I start on the actual commissioned piece, I will request you pay me half of the cost of the commission up front. This is to protect me as an artist and to give you, the client, right to demand that I deliver.
